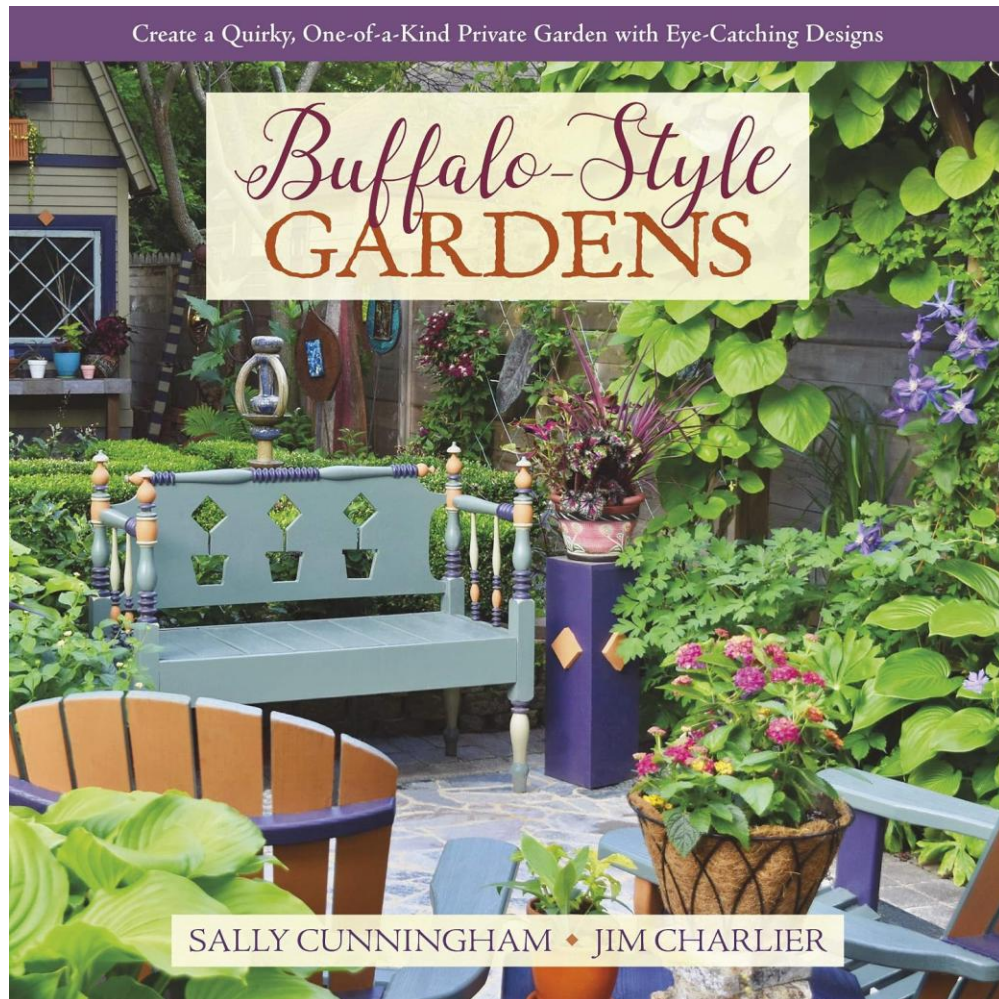
Buffalo Garden Walk: How a Neighborhood Tour Blossomed into a Summer Garden Festival

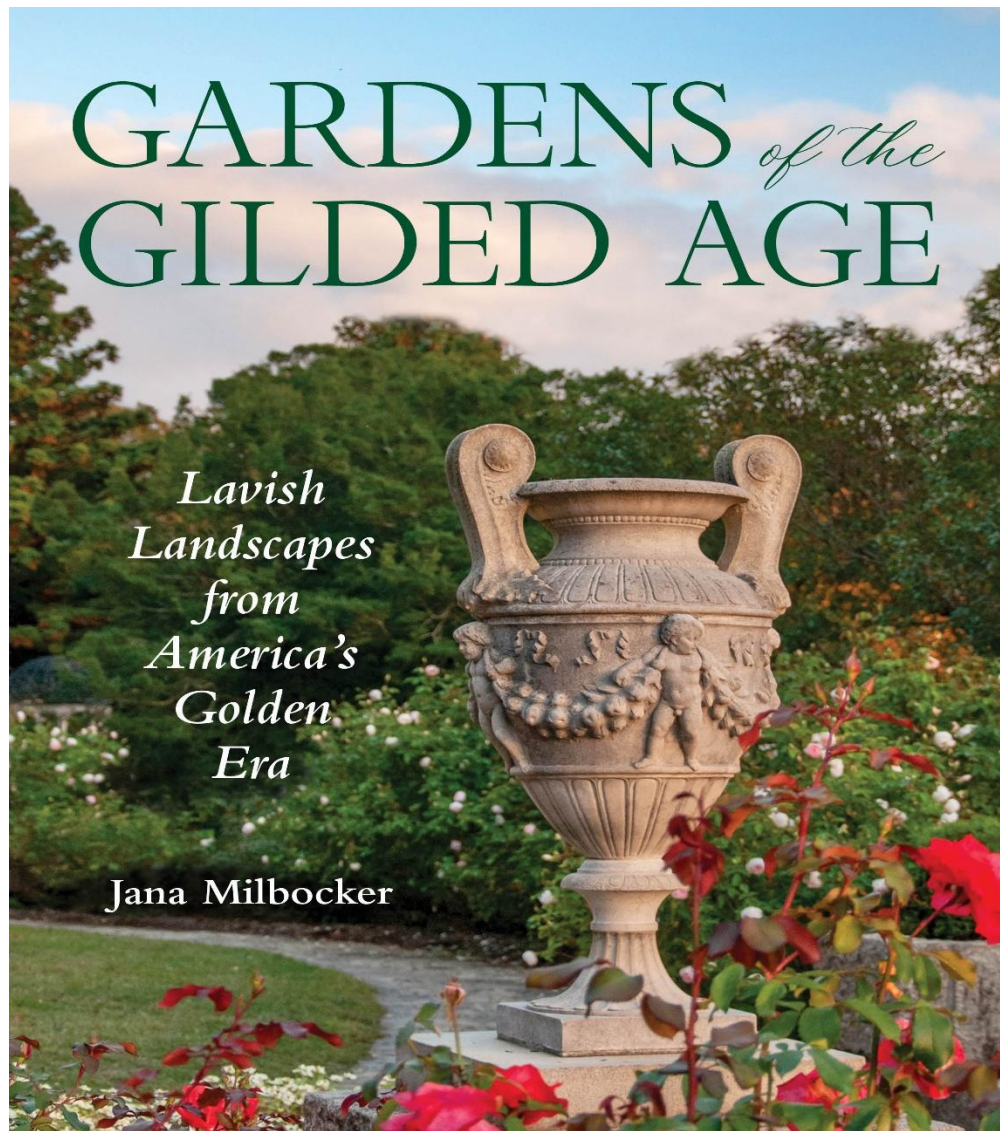


Fairytrail Bride Cascade Hydrangea

Since its unveiling at the Chelsea Flower Show in 2018, Fairytrail Bride® Cascade Hydrangea® (*Hydrangea x*) has continued to captivate gardeners with its unique horizontal habit and romantic elegance. It was the first Cascade

Hydrangea sold in North America, and developed as part of Proven Winners' Fairytrail series by Japan's Ushio Sakazaki. It sets buds at every leaf node, with deckle-edged white flowers along the entire length of its trailing stems. Fairytrail Bride Cascade Hydrangea thrives in Zones 5–9, in part sun and moist, well-drained soil. It's attractive in patio pots and hanging basket, and in the landscape it can grow to 4' in height and width. Available from Proven Winners.
